



Rubber Chippings

Overview

Rubber is a cost-effective surface material typically placed over silica sand to provide insulation and increased cushioning. It can be added to new or existing surfaces and is suitable for general use.

Our high-quality rubber chippings range between 5-20mm in size and are 99.9% wire-free. Depending on your requirements, we can arrange for the material to be delivered in either tonne bags or loose in a rigid tipper

To keep them at their optimum performance level, sand and rubber surfaces require regular irrigation. If allowed to dry out, the underlying sand will become unstable, and the surface will ride deep.






Surface Maintenance

Riding arena surfaces are a substantial investment, and implementing a regular maintenance regime is the best way to help prolong their lifespan and keep them consistent in their performance.

Your maintenance plan should be designed around your surface type and personal circumstances, although several tasks should be completed as a matter of 'best practice', including:

- Removing all droppings from the surface as quickly as possible
- Regularly grading or harrowing your footing using the correct type of equipment
- Watering non-waxed surfaces as required
- Checking the depth of your surface at various points across your arena

When purchasing your grader, choosing the right equipment for your surface is essential. Graders can either be tractor mounted or towable and typically range between 1.5m to 3m in width. Most sand and fibre-based surfaces require a grader with height-adjustable tines and, ideally, a crumbler roller to both the front and back. It is also beneficial if the grader has a plate that can be popped out to bring the surface in from the kickboards.

Membranes

Overview

Membranes come in two types, with each playing a different but equally important role in the construction of your riding arena.

Lower membranes are typically used to separate your drainage stone from the ground. We offer a standard lower membrane made from woven polypropylene that is strong, durable and resistant to all-natural acids and alkalis.

Upper membranes are made from a non-woven geotextile and are used to separate your riding arena surface from the drainage stone. We can supply needle punched and thermally bonded membranes in three different thicknesses, depending on whether your arena will have a standard, intermediate or high level of use.



Equi-Drain™ can be used to separate your riding arena surface from the underlying drainage stone instead of a geotextile membrane.



Overview

Equi-Drain™ is a stone-blinding system used to separate your riding arena surface from the drainage layer, eliminating the need for a non-woven geotextile membrane.

Instead, the Equi-Drain™ system uses a slightly smaller 4/20mm sized cleanstone to construct your riding arena's drainage layer, which is then topped with a 2/6mm fine grit to create a level and stable base on which to lay your chosen surface.

Unlike conventional geotextile membranes, Equi-Drain™ is a free-draining system that will not block, become damaged or develop into a trip hazard should your surface become too thin.
